 - 7) Thesis/Dissertation Metadata Form (M.Phil./Ph.D.)
 - 8) Consent Form for Digital Archiving (M.Phil./Ph.D.)
 - 9) Synopsis Submission Form (Ph.D.)

- 5. The Research Committee recommends to extend the last date of Ph.D. Registration for the batch of PET-2019 qualified candidates from 30-06-2020 to 30-09-2020 on the basis of UGC guidelines.
- 6. The Research Committee recommends to proceed further for Ph.D. Entrance Test from October, 2020.
- 7. The Research Committee recommends to consider the applications for giving extra time to the current M.Phil./Ph.D. candidates (who are already registered) to submit their Dissertations/Theses due to CORONA-2019 Pandemic, if any.
- 8. The Research Committee recommends to conduct online Viva-Voce Examination of M.Phil./Ph.D. candidates as per the UGC guidelines. In online Viva-Voce Examination, M.Phil./Ph.D. candidate and his/her Supervisor/Guide will remain present in the Multi-Media Room/Viva Room of the University campus. The external examiner/referee will only be out of campus. He/she will conduct Viva-Voce Examination from his/her place through ONLINE mode. No any external examiner/referee will be called upon in the University campus solely for Viva-Voce Examination purpose.
- 9. Dr. Satrughna Panigrahi suggested to amend the Paper No. 3 of M.Phil. Course. The Committee recommends this suggestion of amending Paper No. 3 of M.Phil. Course to the Academic Section to put it before the next meeting of Board of Studies, as this is the matter of syllabus/curriculum and does not come under the purview of the Research Committee. The Committee suggests that Dr. Satrughna Panigrahi will inform the same to the Academic Section individually.
- 10. Dr. Satrughna Panigrahi suggested to amend the mode of examination of Paper No. 4 of M.Phil. Course, especially in the matter of Viva-Voce Examination. The Committee recommends this suggestion of amending Paper No. 3 of M.Phil. Course to the Academic Section to put it before the next meeting of Board of Studies, as this is the matter of syllabus/curriculum and does not come under the purview of the Research Committee. The Committee suggests that Dr. Satrughna Panigrahi will inform the same to the Academic Section individually.
- 11. Dr. Dipesh Katira suggested to amend the mode of M.Phil. Entrance Test (MET) by amending MET syllabus. He suggested to insert subject test too with MCQ test in the MET. The Committee recommends to form the Committee for this purpose. The concerned Committee will submit the detailed report with MET syllabus, structure and MET paper blue print.
